

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

- The name of this organization is: South Sudan Kuku Association of North America (SSKANA).
- SSKANA was conceptualized in June 1998 and its constitution was written and officially confirmed by membership in December 1998.
- The main purpose of SSKANA is: to help our less fortunate orphaned brothers and sisters, victims of Sudan civil war, shelter, medical and educational assistance, likewise to promote our culture, heritage and help members to prepare for gainful participation in all aspects of life in the United States of America.

This organization is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, SSKANA shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

Upon winding up and dissolution of this organization after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of SSKANA, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation, religious, and scientific purposes and which has established its exempt status under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
